**L. E. Tanttú** have for many years created and printed posters by hand in their Jollygoodfellow Printing Studio. Now they complement with textiles for the wall. "We have long thought about textiles in interior design, they have a great ability to soften and to dampen sound. In our home we like to have as much light as possible, so we skip curtains, instead we choose to hang the fabric on the wall. "
